Thank you for reaching out to Delegate Batten's office. Delegate Batten appreciates your taking the time to share that article and your opposition to [HB1965](#) (2021). Under that law, the Air Pollution Control Board is required to adopt laws that match California's as soon as they are certified by the Federal Environmental Protection Agency to meet the standards of the Clean Air Act. Virginians have no voice in Sacramento, and this policy of prohibiting the sale of non-electric-powered cars in Virginia by 2035 is grossly impractical. Because of this, House Republicans have already begun work on legislation to introduce in the 2023 legislative session to repeal that unfeasible policy.
