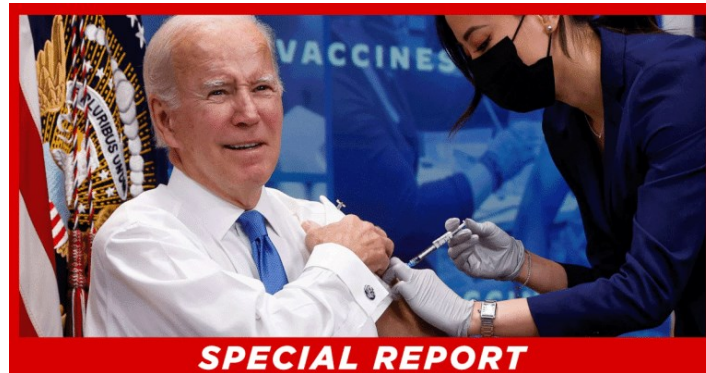


Biden Exposed in Major COVID Cover-up: Administration Hid Evidence Supporting Lab Theory
