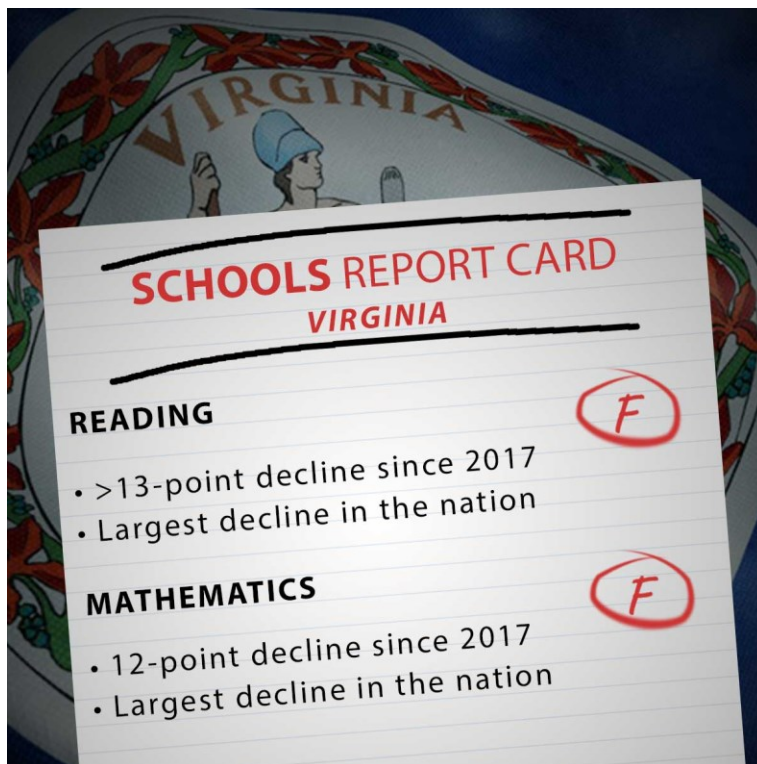

Yesterday, data from the 2022 National Assessment of Educational Process (NAEP) was released. Known as the "Nation's Report Card", this data confirmed what we've known for quite awhile- Virginia students suffered from Democrat leadership.

For the first time in 30 years, Virginia fourth graders have fallen below the national average in reading and are struggling to stay above the national average in math. Since 2017, 4th grade students across Virginia suffered the **largest declines in reading and math in the nation.**

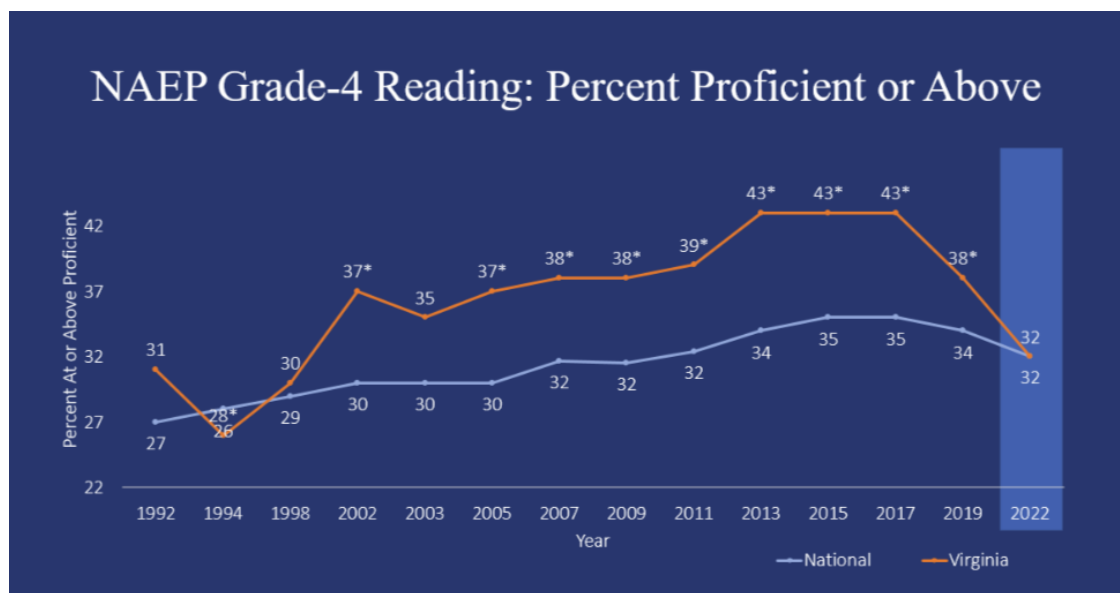


For Virginia, **this is simply unacceptable.**
