What Is Democratic Legality?

Since 2021, the left has waged a veritable war against the American legal system in a variety of ways.

One serial target of Democrats and the Left has been the Supreme Court.

In 2020, Senate Minority Leader Chuck Schumer (D-NY) spoke to an angry throng of pro-abortion protestors assembled at the very doors of the court chambers.

He threatened two of the justices, Kavanaugh and Gorsuch, by name. Schumer yelled to the volatile crowd that the justices' views would make them "*reap the whirlwind,*" and the two would not know what "*hit*" them.

In the ensuing months, protestors mobbed some of the conservative justices' homes—likely committing felonies. The sympathetic Biden Justice Department chose not to follow the law, and so did nothing, although eventually a would-be assassin turned up.

Joe Biden himself bragged that he would try to ignore the Supreme Court ruling banning his arbitrary cancellation of billions of dollars in student loans. Indeed, he boasted, "*The Supreme Court blocked it, but that didn't stop me.*"

In response, no one on the left ever complained about endangering the "*rule of law*" or Biden as "*a dictator.*"

For three years, four local, state, and federal prosecutors warped the law to neuter Donald Trump. Most of the charges had never been brought against other political figures in similar circumstances.

The vast majority of the 93 weaponized indictments backfired on the liberal prosecutors, who had contorted the legal system for political purposes and now face their own ethical or legal quagmires.

The federal prosecutor Jack Smith belatedly reported accepting \$140,000 in free legal services.

Georgia prosecutor Fani Willis was removed from the Trump case and fined, and is now under further investigation.

New York prosecutor Letitia James is now facing allegations of falsification of documents and loan fraud.

Federal immigration law prohibits the illegal entry into and residence within the United States. Yet the Biden administration deliberately violated the law by allowing somewhere between 10-12 million illegal aliens to cross the border. Thousands had criminal records.

No one on the left decried any of these various affronts to the legal system.

In polls, by overwhelming majorities—above 70 percent—the public wants the Trump administration to close the border, begin deportations, and start with criminals or those with violent histories and gang ties.

The recent deportation of Kilmar Abrego Garcia, an illegal alien from El Salvador, to the vast majority of Americans seems to fit that profile.

Garcia entered the U.S. illegally and was later found consorting with members of M-13—a State Department-designated terrorist organization—who were selling drugs. Informants reported that he was a gang member. His own tattoos likely confirm those accusations.

Two prior immigration judges found such evidence sufficient to allow deportation proceedings. In 2019, a third judge allowed Garcia to stay temporarily, but only on the grounds that hostile gangs might harm him should he return to El Salvador.

Garcia was pulled over for speeding without a driver's license, but with eight illegal aliens who reportedly all lived at the Garcia residence. The officer released him, despite suspicions that Garcia was engaged in human trafficking.

Garcia's live-in girlfriend, now wife, was physically assaulted by Garcia on two occasions, suffered injuries, and initially sought restraining orders against him. The left claims Garcia is a "*Maryland man*" without an arrest record.

But he is not a U.S. citizen or a legal resident of Maryland. Instead, Garcia is in legal limbo and remains what he always was—a citizen of El Salvador with gang ties and formerly residing illegally in the U.S.

Garcia is now back home on El Salvadorian soil and was mistakenly sent to a high-security prison. But his own government in El Salvador will ultimately decide how involved Garcia is or was with M-13 gangs. And then, as a sovereign nation, it will act according to its own policies about its own citizens' associations with that terrorist organization.

The left has demanded that Garcia be returned to the U.S. He has become a cause célèbre as a purported victim of the supposedly fascist Trump. Returning Garcia is seen by leftists as a performance art-act to derail the Trump agenda, which otherwise they have neither the power nor public support to thwart.

The left also ignores its own hypocrisies and ironies.

Those who weaponized the court system and destroyed the border now rail that Trump is acting unlawfully by not returning an illegal alien, an M-13 member, and a domestic abuser with a propensity to ignore our laws.

How ironic that those who rail about colonialism now sound like 19th-century Yankee imperialists.

Democrats do not own El Salvador, although they act like it when dictating to its government that El Salvador cannot detain one of its own citizens on its own soil for its own reasons.

Team Trump's Truthful COVID Website **The administration has turned a site once filled with propaganda into a correction of the record.**

If there was a single website that enforced The Narrative™ on COVID-19, it was COVID.gov. It was the source for Leftmedia reports and censorial “*fact-checks.*” And it was essentially propaganda.

Now, when you visit that URL, you get to a new White House website on which Donald Trump’s administration tells the truth about the coronavirus.

Of course, you could have visited Mark Alexander’s comprehensive COVID page, which he’s been updating and documenting since March 2020. Alexander didn’t toe Anthony Fauci’s deceitful line, so his now-book-length record didn’t get the notoriety it deserved. (In addition to Alexander’s work, we wrote more than 800 stories on the subject over the last five years.)

For Trump, it’s part of fulfilling his promise to upend the status quo in Washington. In addition to reposting the 557-page report from the House Select Subcommittee on the Coronavirus Pandemic of the Committee on Oversight and Accountability, Trump takes on the biggest lies of COVID by telling the truth — which you knew long ago if you’ve been reading The Patriot Post.

COVID began in the Wuhan Institute of Virology, not in nature or that wet market. Virtually every U.S. intelligence agency has come around to this viewpoint, though the Leftmedia is still heel-dragging.

COVID resulted from gain-of-function research funded in part by the United States. “*A lab-related incident involving gain-of-function research is the most likely origin of COVID-19,*” the site says. “*Current government mechanisms for overseeing this dangerous gain-of-function research are incomplete, severely convoluted, and lack global applicability.*”

Health experts and scientists were wrong, if not outright lying, about measures like social distancing, mask mandates, and lockdowns, which were often “*arbitrary and not based on science.*”

Politicians lied and covered up their actions. For example, New York Governor Andrew Cuomo caused many deaths at nursing homes in his state and lied to Congress about it.

This week, House Oversight Committee Chairman James Comer asked the Justice Department to criminally prosecute Cuomo for his lies and deadly actions. Joe Biden's DOJ ignored the initial criminal referral.

“Let's be clear: lying to Congress is a federal crime. Mr. Cuomo must be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law,” Comer said. *“The House Oversight Committee is prepared to fully cooperate with the Justice Department's investigation into Andrew Cuomo's actions and ensure he's held to account.”*

Speaking of criminal, the new Trump website notes that Fauci was responsible for many of these lies, which is why he received *“a Full and Unconditional Pardon for any offenses against the United States which he may have committed or taken part in during the period from January 1, 2014.”* It was one of many grossly political pardons Biden issued on his way out the door.

This week, the watchdog group OpenTheBooks revealed that Fauci's net worth doubled to about \$15 million between 2019 and 2024. As OpenTheBooks CEO John Hart said in a statement,

“Dr. Fauci's assets soared during the worst of the draconian Covid lockdowns while families and small businesses struggled through school closures and lost income.”

Fauci wasn't the only one who profited. In addition to Biden defying the Supreme Court and robbing taxpayers to pay off student loans, millions of borrowers avoided repayment through a *“pause”* mandated first by Trump and then repeatedly extended by Biden. The Department of Education announced Monday that it will resume collections on accounts that haven't seen payments in years. *“American taxpayers will no longer be forced to serve as collateral for irresponsible student loan policies,”* Education Secretary Linda McMahon said in a statement.

The fraud that resulted from COVID, costing taxpayers trillions of dollars and igniting inflation that cost trillions more, may never be fully known.

Arguably, Trump's biggest mistake in his first term was delegating too much pandemic policymaking to Fauci and others. For many reasons, the pandemic cost him reelection. Now, notes Comer, *“President Trump is rightfully providing the American people with the truth about the COVID-19 pandemic.”* That's absolutely necessary for the record, if not for a reckoning that will be hard to accomplish.

Many Universities Are Rebranding, Not Relinquishing, DEI

Hundreds of schools refuse to shutter Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion on campus.

Leftists don't quit; they rebrand. If a leftist-run university comes up with a dumb idea, it will almost always rebrand to keep that dumb idea alive, even when it has been tried in the real world and proven to be harmful. Such is the case with Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI).

According to the national grassroots organization Defending Education, there are still hundreds of active DEI offices on campuses across the country despite the Trump administration's directive to federally funded colleges and universities to end the illegal and discriminatory DEI practices. A January executive order from President Donald Trump declared:

"Illegal DEI ... policies not only violate the text and spirit of our longstanding Federal civil-rights laws, they also undermine our national unity, as they deny, discredit, and undermine the traditional American values of hard work, excellence, and individual achievement in favor of an unlawful, corrosive, and pernicious identity-based spoils system."

Only 18 universities complied.

Most have outright defied the White House and kept their DEI offices as originally named, such as the entirety of University of California-affiliated schools. Others have simply rebranded their offices. The University of Tulsa has renamed its DEI office the Office for Resilience and Belonging. Kansas State University has renamed its DEI program the Office of Access and Opportunity.

The report summarizes:

To date, Defending Education has tracked 245 universities that still have institution-wide DEI offices and/or programming in operation, 180 schools

or colleges (such as Colleges of Education, Engineering, or Medicine, etc.), and 403 currently have active DEI offices and programming.

Additionally, 28 institutions and schools/colleges appear to have renamed or rebranded their DEI offices, 18 universities have removed webpages and/or shut down DEI initiatives, and in a few cases, the DEI webpage has been moved behind an institutional login.

Trump's Department of Justice is being kept very busy with litigation. President Trump is withholding taxpayer funding from schools that do not comply.

In a speech at the University of Virginia, state Attorney General Jason Miyares quoted an important pair of questions: *"Plato asked ... the two most important questions for civilization: who teaches the children, and what do they teach them?"*

For most, it's public K-12 education, and higher education adds the finishing touches. According to Miyares, what does this education often produce?

"College campus graduates are graduating in two fluent languages. They're fluent in the language of anti-Semitism and fluent in the language of anti-Americanism. That should give all of us pause."

College graduates are also fluent in neo-Marxism, which is at the heart of DEI because it defines people as either oppressor or oppressed based purely on their race, gender, sexuality, or identity.

It has produced scholars who are more inclined to justify the actions of assassins like Luigi Mangione or proclaim the martyrdom of thuggish men like George Floyd than fight to prevent the tragedies that happened to people like Rachel Morin or Austin Metcalf, both white victims slain by aggressors of color. DEI and its poisonous roots are behind this lack of justice, reasoning, or morality.

It's a shame that these schools are so far beyond reason that they cannot voluntarily relinquish their bad ideas, but instead have to be strong-armed by the federal government. Colleges and universities, with the help of their DEI appendages, are gleefully teaching a generation the tenets of greed and hatred. It's up to all of us to undo this warping.

Not a single Secretary of State

will open voter rolls to citizen audits

Every voter roll, in every state in America, is from 8% to over 20% anomalous. That means in every state, the results of a statewide election can be decided by fraudulent mail-in ballots. In four 2024 Senate elections and about a dozen House seats, that is exactly what happened.

We have more than an opinion—we run the voter rolls for over 20 states, and the voter rolls are wildly inaccurate in every one. We don't just run the voter rolls—so do others. What we do that NOBODY on the planet does is cross-compare them, cell by cell, with property tax rolls, known address rolls, NCOA change of address rolls, and national A.I. address matching systems.

That's just part of it. We then take every voter roll and copies of it on different dates, showing movement within the data. Thus, we pick up that 509 Marlboro Street had 3 voters in its 1,100-square-foot, 1-bedroom, 1-bath location in 2020 and 135 voters in 2024. Nobody else can see that—that's why the national voter integrity groups and Secretaries of State refuse to allow us to analyze their data.

We pick up the data that 1,298 "*students*" at a black college in Georgia voted for over a decade from a college dorm with 200 beds. You can see our videos showing some states on Rumble—type in Omega4America, and you can watch a painful video.

There is not a single Secretary of State in America who will submit their state voter rolls to a full citizen audit. That means a Fractal audit - anyone else can join in, we aren't picky - but the minimum analysis includes:

- Compare every voter address with the county property tax rolls, identifying the tens of thousands of voters who claim residence in a place without bedrooms, like a Walmart, UPS location, empty lot, industrial building, or homeless shelter with 20 beds and 200 residents.

- Compare every voter's identity to the state Medicaid database to identify people who both live at an address that does not exist and also vote.
- Compare every voter identity to the state DMV driver license list to determine voter identities that are illegal aliens.
- Compare the 2024 election results, plus any subsequent elections (Wisconsin comes to mind)—compare the mail-in ballots with the NCOA list at that time—synchronized—to determine how many votes were cast in Nevada or Arizona, for example, and counted, yet the person or address or both were not eligible to cast a mail-in ballot.

Just sort the registered voter names by birth year and identify every voter who is registered and not yet born (Pennsylvania), older than Emperor Hadrian (Mississippi), or one of hundreds who are currently voting and is 224 years old (Texas). This kind of audit can be performed in 30 days or less and will, for the first time, give any Secretary of State and every citizen a true picture of the health and accuracy of the state's voter rolls.

Any bets on whether a single Secretary of State in ANY state will take it up? There is no state that will come out without enough anomalous address/voter combos to, in the aggregate, change the outcome of a statewide election. Secretaries of State won't do it, and the national voter integrity orgs will run interference for them. The national voter integrity groups will BS you - and you will let them do it - that they are doing the same thing. They can't, and everyone pretty much is onto them.

Not a single voter integrity organization can run the DMV, Medicaid, and state welfare program rolls against the voter rolls to show clear fraud in ALL of those systems because they use 1980s relational technology and do not have the power to do it.

The Alabama Secretary of State will tell you he is tracking voters who may vote in multiple states. All 3 such voters. He will also charge \$30,000 for the state voter roll, thus making sure nobody can see how bad it is. We have a copy, and it is a joke.

The Mississippi Secretary will tell you he is doing it—and he won't do a bit of it—even after we showed him thousands of college students voting year after year from a dorm. We guess in Mississippi, it's OK to go to college for a decade.

The Secretary in Texas will not only refuse to do it, but she will also deny giving the Fractal team the state voter rolls the team BOUGHT for \$1,600. We had to get the state AG to spank her—literally, of course.

The hapless Ohio Secretary of State will find a couple of dozen illegals on the voter rolls - do a huge press release on it - while he ignores literally tens of thousands of Ohio voters who should never get a mail-in ballot, yet do, year after year.

More than a dozen Secretaries of State sent a letter to Kristi Noem saying they want access to the national database of illegals, which even Kristi doesn't have, so they can compare their voter rolls to find Pedro Gonzales and Juan Martinez. These states include Georgia, Kansas, Mississippi, Missouri, New Hampshire, Ohio, and Utah - many of which you will find on our videos showing how corrupt their voter rolls are - BEFORE chasing illegal aliens.

These Secretaries of State won't do a temporal analysis of their voter rolls to find the tens of thousands of college students voting for a decade after they leave for a job across the country. They won't analyze the Job Corps centers to ID the people who are now living under a bridge in a warm state, but have been getting mail-in ballots at those locations for a decade. They won't raise hell about the dozen or two registered voters, with mail-in ballots voting from an RV park in Mississippi or Kansas, with a photo on the front gate - visible on Google Maps - "*No registrations for more than 2 weeks.*" Yet a few dozen people have cast mail-in ballots for years from such places.

This week, in Epoch Times, the Secretaries of State for several states, mostly Republicans, complained they could not get access to the federal databases they needed. That is a BS Secretary of State puff story if we ever saw one. They included Alabama, Ohio, and Idaho, but weeks earlier, 13 or so states sent that same request to Noem.

This, people, is gaslighting on steroids. You, the citizens, are being gaslit or gaslighted, whichever you choose, and you continue to believe the nonsense that the Trump Administration is committed to cleaning up voter fraud. We met with some of these clowns, and let me tell you, they are almost universally the least honest people in politics, which is a sewer.

The Secretary of State is the political semi-pro ball position, the AAA baseball equivalent, or the NFL practice squad of politics. It is a useless sinecure where

colorless people get elected to offices where state budgets are plentiful to make their name known. Take a look at governors, attorneys general, and other higher offices, and their stepping stone is the Secretary of State. We are pretty sure there are no Secretaries of State who held the job for decades - building a fabulous voter roll, clean as a hound's tooth - then retiring after a career of selfless public service. Please, find one, just one.

So Secretaries of State are politicians on the move. They want to move up, and that means they need no controversy in their present gig. So they will mightily complain that the federal government is hiding, in some bank vault, some obscure database they need to make their voter rolls even more perfect than they are today.

Since we have been in the room with many of these losers, showing them live videos of their crappy voter rolls, or in some cases doing queries of their data while they watched - we know there is nothing you can show them which will drive action. Nothing.

In Missouri, we showed the Secretary of State (the previous guy) and a room of lawyers who work for him 41,000 ineligible voters whose status was changed from “inactive” to “active.” They voted, then promptly changed back. The room was stunned. They not only took no action, but they also would not return our calls.

Now, to those who say there is no voter fraud, we suspect we pointed out 41,000 felonies—but maybe that's cool in Missouri. We don't want to judge—we are data guys, not lawyers. We showed the Missouri guys the 41 voters who had registered and were voting from a hotel in Branson. We called the hotel, and they said they never took reservations for more than a week.

In Alabama, we showed the Secretary of State 109-year-old voters—a guy I recall—voting from a sorority house, 40-something voters—mostly men—voting from a woman's rehab facility, and, of course, thousands of voters voting for more than a decade from the same college dorm room. The Alabama voter roll data was so egregious that it was our demo system for two years!

In Kansas, we showed over 40,000 registered voters who were at incorrect addresses, not to mention one guy living in a closed prison and a bunch living in places without bedrooms. The President of their state Senate, some guy called Masterson, invited us in to show this stuff—which we paid for—and when we did the hour-long Kansas video, he said, “...*the Fractal findings were not well received.*”

Utah was by far the most promising. We met with members of the legislature multiple times and some very curious auditors who asked us to do more than poke around, to do a video. They were apparently interested in what we found - and did not find, because 2/3 of the voter rolls are not visible even to them - they passed a thing in the state legislature - to bring us in to do an audit. If Lyman runs again, and he should, we were told in the future those petitions will be digital and we will be on site in beautiful Utah comparing every signature's identity with the property records and our other databases so Lyman doesn't get screwed again.

As if you, the citizen who just wants to get to soccer practice after work and expects clean elections, haven't been played enough, this week you got it again. Did you see the breathless story in the conservative news that Tulsi Gabbard, the head of all things national intelligence, said they found voting machines were vulnerable to hacking? There could not be more raw meat tossed into the cage of ravenous, starving, and beaten conservatives than that headline. But what didn't she say?

The Director of National Intelligence learned that voting machines can be hacked. Some can be accessed from the internet. Who doesn't know that? There are studies all over the place showing modems where they should not be, crappy operating systems, old software - the playground for hackers.

What didn't she say?

"Tulsi Gabbard reported today that her organization reviewed the logs for the voting machines in the 4 recent Senate races the Republicans lost in 2024 and found votes were switched in the machines after being cast. Gabbard then reported her team reviewed every cast mail-in ballot in those 4 elections, compared the address of that ballot to the property tax records

and other databases, and will shortly publish the numbers of ballots illegally cast in those elections.”

We hope you enjoy reading those lines here because you won't ever read them for real. Gabbard isn't going to do a thing about those voting machines—there will not be log file reviews, and she certainly isn't going to check those mail-in ballot addresses.

This is how you, the citizen, are being played - again and again - and it won't stop until we can run a real-time review, starting when mail-in ballots can be requested to the election, cross-searching everyone against multiple databases to find the massive anomalous data in every such roll.

Do not lose hope. Well, you can lose hope in the government because they aren't going to do anything—they will continue to gaslight you. However, we and our teams are doing it—a little at a time—and our results are staggering.
