

Joe Scarborough Attacks Own Viewers Over Support for Pro-Palestinian Protestors

MSNBC viewers who may support the civil protest on college campuses were reportedly criticized by Joe Scarborough for being “too stupid” to see it aiding in the re-election of former President Donald Trump, as live footage of police officers clashing with pro-Palestinian protestors broadcast on viewers’ screens.

Law enforcement agencies in California are presently utilizing tear gas and flash grenades to dismantle a pro-Palestinian protest encampment situated on the UCLA campus.
