

Trump Fires Biden/Harris Official After She's Caught 'Burrowing' into His Labor Department

"Elizabeth Peña was terminated, effective today," confirmed an individual with direct knowledge of staffing decisions. "The Administration is actively working to ensure no other political operatives from the Biden-Harris administration were secretly burrowed into the government."
