Despite the unprecedented crisis on the southern border, we have yet to see any solutions from the Biden Administration. At least 1.7 million migrants tried to enter the U.S. illegally in the last 12 months. *This is the highest annual number of apprehensions of illegal immigrants attempting to cross the border since 1960.*

President Biden and Democrats in Congress are not interested in securing the border. According to new government data, Immigration and Customs Enforcement arrests plunged after President Biden took office. Officers working in the agency's Enforcement and Removal Operations made about 72,000 administrative arrests during fiscal year 2021, marking the lowest levels in over a decade. Since being in office President Biden has signaled to the rest of the world that our borders are open.

This historic border crisis is not going to fix itself. I have to wonder when we will finally see action from the Biden Administration. We are a nation of laws, and we need to take immediate and decisive action to fix the crisis on our southern border.

I have, and will continue to, take action in Washington such as becoming a proud Co-sponsor of *H.R. 4828, the Border Security for America Act of 2021*. This bill would secure the nation's international borders while also supporting our federal law enforcement officers and agents. I will continue to advocate for common sense solutions like this to ensure our nation's immigration laws and programs work properly, are enforced, funded fully, and put the American people first. I encourage the Biden Administration and my colleagues to do the same.
